### From The Boss

Hi Everyone.

Thought we would just touch base with you all in this these trying times. We so hope that you are all well through these scary weeks. Hopefully for some of you it is giving more time for you to spend with your dogs. Just a word of warning though. If your dog is spending a large amount of extra time with you please ensure that you make sure that he spends time on his own otherwise when you return to work and he is left alone you may have problems with barking or separation anxiety.

Obviously, it is subject to the decisions of the Government but at this stage we are looking at starting back on the Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. This date may well change but we feel that we need to have a date in mind. We will confirm this after the Government announcement on the 11<sup>th</sup> May.

I have been talking to a close friend of mine who is a Veterinarian and she was saying that they have had an increase in severe trauma injuries in dogs caused by being hit by vehicles while being walked off lead. More dogs are being walked more often and at times not in a controlled manner. You may think your dog is well behaved and would never run away but what about if another dog came out of a property and rushed at it.

Meanwhile take care and hopefully we will see you all again from the 23<sup>rd</sup> May onwards.

# Tevra Boarding / Day Care Kennels

We have fully fenced secure areas. Five sheds accommodate 12 dogs with enclosed kennels and runs. Various other kennels and runs suitable for dogs of all sizes as well as a family area with their own runs and fenced area.
